

IMPORTANT ELECTION UPDATE

MAY 2, 2020 GENERAL/SPECIAL ELECTION POSTPONED TO NOVEMBER 3, 2020

On March 13, 2020, the Governor of the State of Texas certified that the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) poses an imminent threat of disaster and, under the authority vested in the Governor by Section 418.014 of the Texas Government Code, declared a state of disaster for all counties in Texas.

On March 18, 2020, the Governor issued a Proclamation suspending certain sections of the Texas Election Code, among others, to allow political subdivisions of the State that would otherwise hold elections on May 2, 2020, to postpone General and Special Elections to the next uniform election date, which will occur on November 3, 2020.

On March 26, 2020, the City Council of the City of Kirby voted to postpone the City's May 2, 2020, General/Special Election until November 3, 2020.
