a. Presentation And Discussion On City Of Kirby Funds

Tina Ynfante, Finance Director, defined General Fund Usage Police, Water Fund Usage Policy and Debt Service Fund.

b. Discussion And Direction On City Of Kirby Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Budget

The departments presenting their capital items for consideration were as follows:

Fire Department – 2021 Pierce Enforcer firetruck (\$665,509); training simulator (\$20,698) and Tyler Software with dispatch (\$23,000).

Parks Department – Replaster pool (\$111,000); Friendship Park – restrooms (\$6,400); Friendship Park – entrance (\$38,804); Friendship Park – Patch parking lot (\$10,125); Friendship pavilion area – (\$70,500)

Streets Department – Crest Lane bridge – Engineering and survey (\$20,000); Crest Lane Bridge - Construction – (\$100,000); Intersection of Old Seguin Road and Ackerman (\$32,466); maintenance of Featherrock and French Sea Street using the maintenance tax (Approximately \$70,000).
