a. Discussion And Direction On City Of Kirby Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Budget

The departments presenting their capital items for consideration were as follows:

Police Department – Symphony Consoles (\$102,773); Vistacom Recorder (\$41,795); Radio Director IP Upgrade (\$39,108).

Animal Services Department – Part-time employee (\$12,400); Insulation for shelter building (\$9,917).

Water Department – Well #3 repairs (\$15,580); Drainage Assessment (\$45,000); Ackerman Road sewer project, Hickory Hill dr. sewer (\$150,000); Rehabilitation project Gaiety Lane sewer (\$58,622); Rehabilitation project (\$362,127); Generator and other accessories (\$13,555); fire hydrants (\$170,000).

Street Department – Crest Lane Bridge – Engineering and surveying (\$20,000) Crest Lane Bridge – Construction, etc. (\$100,000); Old Seguin Road and Ackerman Road Intersection (\$32,466).

Parks Department – Replaster Pool (\$110,000); Friendship Restroom Friendship Park entrance (\$6,400); Friendship Park – patches (\$38,804); Friendship Park – parking lot – (\$10,125); Pavilion area at Friendship Park (\$70,500).
