AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRBY AMENDING ORDINANCE O-2022-911; AMENDING THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 30 SECTION 30.07 CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS DECORUM AND DEBATE AND SECTION 30.10 CITIZEN PARTICIPATION AT MEETINGS; ADDING SECTIONS 30.11 AND 30.12 RELATED TO CARRYING OF WEAPONS ON CITY OWNED PREMISES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the city of Kirby, Texas is a home-rule municipality located in Bexar County, Texas and duly established under the Texas Constitution and the laws of this State; and

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code Section 551.007(a) provides that a governmental body shall allow citizens to address the body at the meeting before or during the body's consideration of an item;

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code Section 551.007(b) provides that a governmental body may adopt reasonable rules, including those that limit the total amount of time that a member of the public may address the body; and

WHEREAS, in opinion No. KP-0300, the Attorney General of Texas stated that a governmental body "may satisfy subsection 551.007(b)'s requirements by having a single public comment period at the beginning of an open meeting to address all items on the agenda"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that revisions should be made to portions of Sections 30.07 and 30.10 of the Code of Ordinances to ensure consistency as to what vote of the City Council is needed to extend time for citizen comment during City Council meetings; and

WHEREAS, Sections 30.07 and 30.10 of the Kirby Municipal Code includes provisions as to the Rules of Procedure relating to City Council Members Decorum and Debate and citizen participation at the meetings of City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Kirby to amend the current code sections related to Council decorum and citizens comments and allow the City Council meetings to run in an efficient and orderly manner, and to effectively conduct government business, and establish rules related to citizen participation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary to establish regulations for firearms on City owned property; and

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter of the City of Kirby Section 11.01 gives the City Council authority to abolish, modify or alter such ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Kirby to adopt the revised and additional sections of Chapter 30 of the City's Code of Ordinances.

### NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRBY, TEXAS, THAT:

- **Section 1.** Amendments. The Kirby Code of Ordinances Chapter 30, Sections 30.07 and 30.10 and additions of Sections 30.11 and 30.12 are hereby amended as shown in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated for all purposes. Deletions are noted as strikethroughs and additions as underlined.
- **Section 2.** Findings. That the recitals contained in the preamble hereto are hereby found to be true and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the Council.
- **Section 3.** Cumulative Clause. This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the City of Kirby, Texas, except where the provisions of the Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed. Any renumbering shall be made as necessary in the City's Code of Ordinances as necessary.
- **Section 4. Severability**. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.
- **Section 5. Public Meeting.** That it is officially found, determined and declared that the meeting at which this Ordinance is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this ordinance, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.

**Section 6.** Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and any publication requirements.

### Exhibit A

**CHAPTER 30: CITY COUNCIL** 

#### § 30.07 CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS DECORUM AND DEBATE.

In support of and respect for open, fair, and informed decision-making process, the City Council, Committees and Boards recognize that:

- Civil, respectful, and courteous discourse and behavior are conducive to the democratic and harmonious airing of concerns and decision making; and
- Uncivil discourse and/or discourteous and inappropriate behavior have a negative impact on character and productivity of the decision-making process.
- In an effort to preserve the intent of open government and maintain a positive environment for citizen input and City Council, Boards, Commission, Committees decision-making, the following Meeting Protocol and Rules of Decorum have been adopted.

Compliance with the meeting protocol is expected and will be enforced. A printable version of the Meeting Protocol will be made available on the City of Kirby website.

- A.) Speaking. When a measure is presented for consideration to the Council, the presiding officer shall recognize the appropriate individual to present the matter. When 2 or more members wish to speak, the presiding officer shall name the member who is to speak first. No member of the Council shall interrupt another while speaking, except to make a point of order. The presiding officer shall not be obligated to recognize any Council member for a second comment on the subject or amendment until every Council member wishing to speak has been allowed a first comment. Council members shall also have the right to yield the floor to another member.
- B.) Motion to Move The Question. If, during debate upon any ordinance, resolution, motion or other matter before the Council, any member moves that the subject under discussion be put to a vote without further debate, and the motion is seconded, the presiding officer shall immediately and without debate put the question, "Shall the subject being discussed be put to a vote?" to a vote of the Council, and if is of the Council members present vote in favor of ordering the vote, debate on the question shall be closed and a vote on the ordinance, resolution, motion or other measure shall betaken immediately.
- C.) Etiquette. Council members shall notindulge or engage in anger, rudeness, ridicule, personal attacks, use obscene or profane language, arraign motives of Council members or staff, charge deliberate misrepresentation of the City or staff, or use language tending to hold a member of the City Council or staff up to contempt.
- D.) Seating. All persons attending a Public Meeting shall remain seated in the seats provided, unless addressing the body at the podium or entering or leaving the meeting.
- E.) Council Addressing City Business. No member shall speak more than 5 minutes on any question oramendment to the question except as further provided in this rule.
  - No member shall speak more than the time limits provided on any subject or amendment, but such member may use such member's time in any combination, in separate speech or comments totaling the number of minutes permitted.
- F.) Any member deciding to speak more than 5 minutes on any question or more than 5 minutes on any amendment to the question shall be accorded the privilege only upon motion supported by a vote of at least 4 members of the Council. Enforcement. If a member is speaking without being recognized or otherwise violating any of the rules of the Council, the presiding officer shall, or any Council member may, call such member to order in which case such member shall immediately be quiet unless permitted to explain. The Council shall, if appealed to, decide the matter without debate. If the decision is in favor of the member called to order, such member shall be at liberty to proceed, but not otherwise, and if the disruption continues, such member shall be liable to censure or to such punishment as the Council deems proper and consistent with applicable State statutes or city ordinances.

If a Council member is transgressing the rules of the Council, the presiding officer shall, or any Council member may call such member to order, in which case such member shall immediately be quiet unless permitted to explain. The Council shall, if appealed to, decide the matter by a vote of at least 4 members of the City Council without debate. If the decision is in favor of the member called to order, such member shall then be at liberty to proceed, but not otherwise, and in any event only in compliance with these rules.

In accordance with Robert's Rules of Order, the City Council may override any decision of the presiding officer regarding the conduct and handling of the Council meeting. In order for a decision of the presiding officer to be overruled, there must be a motion, a second, and a vote by at least 4 members of the City Council overruling the decision of the presiding officer.

#### § 30.10 CITIZEN PARTICIPATION AT MEETINGS.

- (A) Rules for speakers. Citizens will be allowed to speak at a meeting; provided, they have signed the Citizen Participation form utilizing their name, home address, and listed the specific agenda items to be addressed, however, before a member of the public may address City Council or speak at a meeting, the presiding officer must first recognize the member of the public who wishes to speak and announce that the person may proceed.
  - 1. All guests and other persons who are to speak to the City Council, including staff members, other than theCity Manager, City Attorney, or City Secretary, shall wait in the audience until recognized. When called by the presiding officer for an opportunity to be heard, that person shall move immediately to the podium and make their comments. Impromptu person al points of order, comments, objections or questions shall not be recognized, and If they persist, after the Presiding Officer has warned of the offense, a member of the public engaging in such conduct shall, at the discretion of the Presiding Officer or a majority of the City Council, be subject to ejection from the meeting.2. The purpose of addressing the City Council is to formally communicate to the Council on matters relating to City business or citizen concerns. Persons addressing the City Council on an agenda item shall confine the subject matter of their remarks to the particular matter before the Council.
  - 3. No person except City Officials shall be permitted within the platform area in front of Council dais without the prior consent of the Presiding Officer or City Manager.
  - 3. Behavior. No person attending Public Meetings shall engage in disorderly or boisterous conduct-including but not limited to applause, whistling, stomping of feet, booing, or making any loud, threatening, profane, abusive, racist, sexist, obscene, personal, impertinent, or slanderous utterance—that disturbs, disrupts, or otherwise impedes the orderly conduct of the meeting. No person shall engage in defamation, intimidation, personal affronts, or threats of violence.
  - 4. Remarks. All remarks by members of the public shall be addressed to the council or the governmental body and not to any specific Council, Board or Commission Member.
- (B) Noise In the Lobby or Outside. Noise emanating from the lobby outside the City Council Chambers which is audible within the City Council Chambers shall not be permitted. The Kirby Police Department is authorized to enforce this rule by requesting those in the lobby to remain silent or leave the area.

(C)

Electronics Noise. Within the City Council Chambers, all cell phone and pager ringers shall be turned off; no talking on cell phones is allowed; and all electronic equipment or electronic devices shall be operated in a manner which does not emit sound or disturb other members of the public or disrupt the orderly conduct of the meeting.

- (D) Signs. No placards, banners, or signs will be permitted in the City Council chamber or in any other room in which the City Council is meeting. Exhibits, displays, and visual aids used in connection with presentation to the City Council are permitted.
- (E) Time limit. The presiding officer, or the City Council by a vote of at least 4 members of the City Council, may set a reasonable time limit for any citizen or person in attendance who desires to address the Council or speak at a meeting.
  - Total time for public comment on any subject under Citizen Participation shall be 5 minutes per speaker except as indicated in Subparts H and I hereof. All persons are only allowed to speak once and their time allotted shall not be transferred to another individual to accumulate their speaking time. By an affirmative vote of at least 4 members of the City Council, the time limitations of this rule may be extended.
- (F) *identification*. All members of the public speaking before Council shall preface their statements with their name and home address for the record.
- (G) Speaking from the podium. The speaker shall remain at the podium until the Mayor has dismissed the speaker. Speaking from the podium will assure that the recording equipment picks up the presentation.
- (H) Spokesperson. Speakers with similar or common interests are encouraged to select someone to act as a spokesperson in order to move the proceedings along. The presiding officer may urge the implementation of this rule at anytime.
- (I) Public comments and receipt of petition. The public comment period will not be used to air personal grievances, nor to make political endorsements or for political campaign purposes. Speakers shall address all comments to the government body and not to individual council members. Discussions between speakers and members of the audience shall not be allowed. Any person desiring to be heard by the City Council on any matter shall be heard during that part of the meeting reserved for Citizen Participation or public comments, presentation of a petition or, on matters related to the subject of a public hearing, during the time scheduled for a public hearing.
- (J) Scheduled speakers. Speakers may request, in writing, an opportunity to be placed on the agenda to speak at a meeting concerning a specific matter, as identified in their written request. A written request to be placed on the agenda to speak must be delivered to the City Secretary, or the City Secretary's designee, by noon on Wednesday the week preceding the regular, special, or workshop meeting of the City Council. In the event that the number of speakers who request to be scheduled on the agenda indicates that the comments will be lengthy or repetitious, the presiding officer may schedule such matter for a public hearing or make other appropriate arrangements to ensure that the conduct of the City's business is not unduly impeded. The City Manager or the Mayor shall determine whether to put a specific item on an agenda as requested by a speaker.
- (K) Citizen participation. Citizen comments may be made during the "citizens participation" portion of the meeting. Any person wishing to address the council must sign the register which will be provided. Citizen comments shall be limited to 5 minutes per speaker unless otherwise specified by the chair. Notwithstanding the foregoing, so long as the City does not have simultaneous translation equipment that allows the governmental body to hear translated testimony simultaneously, the time limit for a member of the public who requires the assistance of a translator to address the governmental body and addresses the governmental body through a translator shall be limited to 10 minutes. Time allotted per speaker may not be transferred to another individual to accumulate their speaking time.
- (L) The time limitations set forth herein for remarks by citizens may be extended only by the affirmative vote of at least 4 of the members of the City Council.
- (M) Public criticism. The City Council may not prohibit criticism of the City Council, including criticism of any act, omission, policy, procedure, program, or service. This subsection does not apply to public criticism that is otherwise prohibited by law.

- (N) Camera Recordings. Citizens may record proceedings of the City Council. To avoid disruption of proceedings, persons recording meetings using camcorders, tripods, or similar equipment shall do the recording from the last row to the left side of the City Council Chambers being the area behind the railing separating the audience area from the area where members of the City Council are seated. Persons recording meetings using a handheld cell phone may record from other parts of the public seating area at City Hall so long as they do not obstruct the view of others attending the Council meeting.
- (O) Persons Needing a Translator. Persons needing a translator must notify the City Secretary in writing of their request for a translator at least 48 hours prior to the start time of the meeting at which they intend to speak to the City Council. The request must specify the language that is to be translated into English. The City is not obligated to provide a translator.
- (P) Enforcement of the Rules of Decorum for Meetings.
  - The Presiding Officer shall be responsible for Maintaining the decorum at the Public Meeting and uniformly enforcing the Rules of Decorum.
     Breach of Decorum. In the event that any person breaches the Rules of Decorum in a manner that disturbs, disrupts, or otherwise impedes the orderly conduct of the meeting, The Presiding Officer shall first request that a person violating the rules cease such conduct. If, after receiving a request from the Presiding Officer, the person persists in violating these rules, the Presiding Officer shall order a recess. If upon resumption of the meeting the violation persists, the Presiding Officer shall order another recess, whereupon the Kirby Police Department shall have the authority to order the person ejected from the meeting, or be placed under arrest per Texas Penal Code.
  - 5. If any person threatens by their actions or verbal utterance the safety of the public meeting, the Presiding Officer may order that person to leave the Public Meeting and shall also be removed from City Property.
  - 6. Clearing the Room. In the event that any meeting is willfully interrupted by a group of groups of persons as to render the orderly conduct of such meeting unfeasible and order cannot be restored by the removal of the individuals who are willfully interrupting the meeting, The presiding officer may order the council chambers to be cleared and the meeting shall continue in session. Representatives of the press or other news media, except those participating in the disturbance, shall be allowed to attend any session.
  - 7. Authority of Mayor. The Mayor has the authority to remove an Individual from a public meeting that poses a public safety threat to the Council and/or the public.
    - a) The Mayor or majority-rule of City Council can prohibit an individual from participating in an in person open government meeting or a city-owned property if they are found to pose a public safety threat.
    - b) An individual that poses a public safety threat can be prohibited by the Mayor or a majority-rule of City Council, from entering an open government meeting and any city-owned property for a period of 90 days to not exceed 2 years.
    - c) If the Mayor or a majority-rule of City Council rules in favor of the prohibition, the individual has 5 business days to appeal the ruling with the City.
    - d) The individual prohibited will be given an opportunity to address an open government meeting virtually as to not impose on the right of the individual to address the open meeting.
  - 8. Authority of Law Enforcement. Law Enforcement have authority to remove any person from city-owned property that pose a public safety threat.
- (Q) Violation of Texas Penal Code.

A person or persons who willfully and intentionally impair or impede the conduct of a City Council meeting by violating these rules of decorum may be prosecuted under Texas Penal Code Section 30.05 Criminal Trespass and/or 42.05 Disrupting Meeting or Procession.

# § 30.11 CARRYING OF WEAPONS, INCLUDING CONCEALED HANDGUNS, ON CITY-OWNED PREMISES PROHIBITED

- (A) It is the intent of the city council to prohibit any person other than a commissioned security officer employed by the city and licensed peace officers from carrying or possession weapons including cityowned buildings, parking garages, lots, and other parking areas but excluding city-owned or operated public parks, streets, and sidewalks.
- (B) It is the intent of the city of council that the term weapon shall include a firearm, handgun, bb-gun, and any prohibited item weapon listed in the Texas Penal Code Section 46.05(a) and have the same meaning as said items are defined in Section 46.01, Texas Penal Code.
- (C) The city council informs the city manager, or his designee to post the appropriate signs and such other notice, in accordance with Section 30.05 of the Texas Penal Code (the Criminal Trespass Law), to carry out the city council's above-stated intent.
- (D) The city manager and law enforcement is authorized to take all steps reasonable and necessary to deny entry or continued presence on city-owned premises to all such persons possessing weapons including concealed handguns, including prosecution of such violators for the offense of criminal trespass.

## § 30.12 CARRYING OF WEAPONS, INCLUDING CONCEALED HANDGUNS, ON CITY-OWNED PREMISES PROHIBITED

- (A) It shall be unlawful for any person to carry a firearm within the city limits of the City of Kirby at:
  - 1) A public park; or
  - 2) A public meeting of a governmental body; or
  - 3) A political rally, political parade, or official political meeting; or
  - 4) A nonfirearms-related school, college, or professional athletic event.
- (B) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution for a violation of this provision that:
  - 1) The firearm is being carried by a certified peace officer; or
  - 2) The firearm is being carried by a certified security officer in the performance of his employment.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-**

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRBY, TEXAS, CALLING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 4, 2024 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING (3) COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM AND MAKING PROVISION FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION; AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS WITH THE ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR OF BEXAR COUNTY TO CONDUCT THIS ELECTION; AUTHORIZING THE ELECTIONS TO BE HELD AS A JOINT ELECTION; RESOLVING OTHER MATTERS INCIDENT AND RELATED TO SUCH ELECTION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.01(a) of the Home Rule Charter (the "<u>Charter</u>") of the City of Kirby, Texas (the "<u>City</u>"), the regular City election shall be held annually on the uniform election date in May, or at such other times as may be authorized or specified by State Law; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the offices of the (3) Councilmembers will expire in May 2024 and therefore, the City is required to conduct an election to elect council members for the new term; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that holding a joint election on May 4, 2024, with eligible political subdivisions in accordance with the provisions of Texas Election Code section 271.002 is in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that contracting for election services with the Election Administrator for Bexar County (collectively, the "<u>Elections Administrator</u>") to conduct this election is in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that holding such an election as provided for herein in is the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the City.

### NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRBY, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. An election shall be held on May 4, 2024, in and throughout the City, for the purpose of electing (3) Councilmembers for a two-year term to expire May 2026.

<u>Section 2.</u> At said Election, the candidate receiving the most votes for (3) Councilmembers respectively, shall be declared elected for a term to expire in May 2026.

Section 3. Any candidate desiring to have his or her name on the Official Ballot for said General Election shall, no sooner than Wednesday, January 17, 2024, and no later than Friday, February 16, 2024 at 5:00 p.m., file with the City Secretary an application in writing and in the form prescribed by the Texas Election Code requesting that his or her name be placed on the Official Ballot and declaring as a Candidate for (3) Councilmembers. The name of all eligible candidates whose applications have been duly and timely filed shall be placed on the ballot pursuant to a drawing as provided by law.

- <u>Section 4.</u> The election shall be held in accordance with, and shall be governed by, the election laws of the State of Texas, and conducted in accordance with the terms set forth in the Contracts for Election Services, attached hereto as **Exhibit A.**
- <u>Section 5</u>. The City Secretary is hereby designated as the election officer for the City and is hereby authorized to perform all duties and take all actions as required pursuant to the Election Services or Joint Election Agreement and is further authorized to take any additional actions required by state law.
- <u>Section 6.</u> The Early Voting Locations established for this election are designated on <u>Exhibit B.</u> A list of the City Election Precincts/Vote Centers and the polling places designated for each such election precinct are identified on <u>Exhibit B.</u>
- <u>Section 7.</u> Polling on Election Day\_shall be held at the Vote Center Locations listed on <u>Exhibit B</u> on Saturday, May 4, 2024, as prescribed by applicable law, and, the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- <u>Section 8</u>. The Election Administrator are hereby designated as the Early Voting Clerks to conduct such early voting in the election in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code. The main Early Voting places at which early voting shall be conducted for those living respectively in Bexar County.
  - Jacquelyn Callanen, the Elections Administrator of Bexar County, mailing address 1103 S. Frio, Suite 100 San Antonio, Texas 78207; and
- Section 9. Early voting shall be conducted from Monday, April 22, 2024, through Tuesday, April 30, 2024, with some exceptions of certain Saturdays, Sundays, and official State holidays. The locations and hours for the early voting are attached to this Resolution as  $\underline{\textbf{Exhibit}}$   $\underline{\textbf{A}}$ .
- Section 10. All resident qualified voters of the City shall be permitted to vote at any of the Early Voting locations designated in Bexar. On Election Day, such voters shall vote at any Polling Place/Vote Centers located in their designated election county (Bexar). The election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, as amended, and as may be required by any other law. All election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish.
- Section 11. A substantial copy of this Resolution shall serve as proper notice of the Election. The City Secretary shall post and publish the election notice as required by the Texas Election Code.
- <u>Section 12.</u> The Council authorizes the City Manager, or his/her designee, to negotiate and enter into one or more joint election agreements with other governmental organizations in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code in such form as shall be approved by the City Manager, or his/her designee.
- <u>Section 13.</u> The Council authorizes the City Manager, or his/her designee, to negotiate and enter into contracts with the Elections Administrator to conduct the Election in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code in such form as shall be approved by the City Manager, or his/her designee.

<u>Section 14.</u> The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Resolution for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the Council.

<u>Section 15.</u> All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters ordered herein.

Section 16 This Resolution shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

Section 17. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and this Council hereby declares that this Resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision. The Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the City Secretary of the City to make such technical modifications to this Resolution that are necessary for compliance with applicable Texas or Federal Law or to carry out the intent of this Council, as evidenced herein.

Section 18. All exhibits provided for herein are incorporated by reference.

<u>Section 19.</u> It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.

<u>Section 20.</u> This Resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its final passage and any publication required by law.

WHEREAS, the Entities desire that a joint election be held in order to provide a convenient, simple, and cost-saving election to the voters in their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Entities desire to enter into an agreement setting out their respective duties and responsibilities for the May 4, 2024 election;

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is agreed that the Entities will hold a joint election on Saturday, May 4, 2024 (the "Joint Election") under the following terms and conditions:

The Entities are each required to enter into their own separate contract with ADMINISTRATOR for election services and will hold elections jointly with other Entities in the election precincts that can be served by common polling places, using joint election officer and clerks as ADMINISTRATOR determines is necessary and appropriate.

II.

The Entities agree to conduct early voting jointly. ADMINISTRATOR will arrange for and handle early voting in person and by mail for the Joint Election in accordance with her contracts with those Entities.

III.

The Entities agree that a single ballot, containing all the measures and offices to be voted on at a particular polling place, shall be used in this Joint Election.

IV.

Each Entity is responsible for its own posting of public notices in connection with the Joint Election. ADMINISTRATOR shall be responsible for publishing a Notice of Election in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory as required of all the Entities under Section 4.003 of the Election Code, and each Entity shall pay ADMINISTRATOR its proportionate share of the publishing cost.

V.

Each Entity is responsible for paying ADMINISTRATOR for any and all other election costs, as applicable to the specific Entity and agreed upon by separate contract for election services between each Entity and ADMINISTRATOR.

VI.

ADMINISTRATOR will tabulate the ballots and provide a set of copies of the affidavit page of each return along with the returns of the election, as agreed upon by separate contract between each Entity and ADMINISTRATOR.

VII.

Each Entity will be responsible for canvassing its respective precinct returns for the Joint Election.

VIII.

The Entities agree to comply with any and all applicable state and federal record retention statutes. Each Entity shall be the custodian of its respective election records.

IX.

If an Entity determines not to participate in the Joint Election to be held on Saturday, May 4, 2024, because it has no contested positions, the nonparticipating Entity shall promptly notify ADMINISTRATOR and the other Entities, and this Agreement shall be automatically amended to delete the nonparticipating Entity as a party to the Agreement.

The undersigned persons are the duly authorized signatories of their Entities, and their signatures represent acceptance of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, as passed and approved by their respective governing bodies.

XI.

This Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts. Together the counterparts shall be deemed an executed original instrument. The Entities may execute this Agreement and exchange counterparts of the signature pages by means of facsimile transmission, and the receipt of executed counterparts by facsimile transmission shall be binding on the Entities. Following a facsimile exchange, the Entities shall promptly exchange original signature pages.
